Venceremos staff attended the Conference For Critical Race Studies (CRS) and presented a workshop titled "Reclaiming The Village Through a Chicana/o Student Newspaper". The conference was held in Tucson, Arizona from May 21 to 23, 2009. Venceremos also participated in the "Free Minds, Free People" Conference held in Houston, Texas, where they presented a workshop titled "We Shall Prevail: Media Justice In The Press". The conference was held in Houston, Texas. Representatives will present a workshop titled "Venceremos: How A Chicana/o Student Newspaper And A Classroom Operates As A Borderland" at the MALCS (Mujeres Activas En Letras y Cambio Social. Francisco presented at the Southern California Immigration Coalition (SCIC) conference held in (South Central) Los Angeles on April 11, 2009, and wrote an article on the conference, which has posted on the net and printed in several publications. Francisco continues to work on his political novel *Luz del Dia*. He continues to write regular commentaries called "The Midnight Special".
